

What's Your Number? We've all been asked that question many times. What's your cell phone number? What's your Social Security number? What is your bank account number? What number grade are you in school? What number did your get on your ACT? What's your guess on how many pop tops are in the jar? Recently, an investment company began asking that same question in their marketing campaign. They're asking what your dollar amount number is to bring you safety and comfort

In Matthew the 6th chapter, verses 19-21, the Bible says: "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there you heart will be also." (NIV)

when you retire. So "what is your number?" If a single number can define our safety or comfort or peace, what do we really value?

Jesus tells us *not* to store up treasures in earthly things that can be stolen or that will decay, but to store up treasures in heaven where it cannot be taken away. So simple, yet so difficult to pull off. So easy to read and agree with, yet so tough to put into practice. We all get easily sidetracked with daily concerns, with our need for earthly security. What we must do is to place our security, our hope, in only One, and that One is Jesus, who offers a treasure in heaven that cannot be taken away.

So, ask yourself this question: "What's my number?" Now pause, read the above scripture again. Pause again. As a follower of Jesus, if your number is anything other than one, it's time to refocus and realign your life to the words of Jesus: "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."
